Senior Citizens Council of Delhi appreciates the patience of D.R.Pawar (81 yrs) resident of Safdarjung Enclave in fighting legal battle of eviction proceedings from 2017 to July, 2021 against her daughter -in-law. In the first instance, her daughter -in-law managed to get favorable order in her favor from the Tribunal Court of District

Magistrate (South) on 18.12.2017 on the basis of compromised report from Patwari /Kanugo. The Council had advised him to go for appeal with the Tribunal Court of Divisional Commissioner, Delhi. He got eviction order against his son and daughter -in-law on 10.05.2018 and his house was required to be vacated. But in the meantime, her daughter moved High Court & get extension to vacate for another 6 months. She then filed SLP in Supreme Court and she got another extension of 6 months on 08.10.2018. D.R.Pawar filed SLP against his daughter -in-law & finally Supreme Court ordered to vacate the house by 31.07.2021. His house was ultimately vacated on 02.08.2021 who extended thanks to the Council for their continuous moral support -EDITOR

The quality of life of elderly people in the capital has been greatly affected by Covid-19 says J.R.Gupta, Chairperson , Confederation of Senior Citizens Associations of Delhi. Most of senior citizens remained without job including reduction of interest rates on their fixed deposit . Covid -19 pandemic has imposed many challenges before older people from social isolation , financial penury , psychological issues to elder abuse and neglect . Increased unemployment or joblessness has increased their dependence on others . Elderly people were unable to get proper treatment or regular medicines. Since there is no respite till now, the elderly needed constant assurance of support , help and assistance in case of need."Recreational or entertainment activities for older people should be organised and encourage their participation . Door -step healthcare support systems needed for them including digital training for the affected senior citizens.
