He moved an application under order 12 rule 6 CPC in the Court of Abhishek Kumar, JSCC/ASCJ/GJ(WEST), who ordered on 23.12.2022 to the Tenant to hand over peaceful physical possession within a month. Kartar Singh, (90), resident of Nirankari Colony was harassed, abused, beaten & threatened to lodge false cases by his son, his wife & children residing in the same house with a sole motive to grab his acquired property. He reported the matter to the Council / Confederation on 10.02.2021. The matter was taken up with the Commissioner of Police on 14.02.2021 to take legal action against above persons & also to provide security to the complainant. On the basis of compromised report, his son was able to get DM order dated 31.12.2019. He was advised to file appeal with Tribunal Appellate Authority on 13.02.2020, but his case could not be taken up due to Covid. His case was decided on 22.11.2022 & directed son to handover peaceful possession. He has extended thanks to the Council for their regular moral support & legal guidance from time to time. -Editor

recreational grants to SCAs pending for the last 2 years & also issue necessary directions to concerned officers to release old age pension to 27000 / 50000 senior citizens pending since long. J.R. Gupta also brought to his notice about the decision of 2016 vide which enhanced recreation grant from Rs. 20,000/- to Rs. 30,000/- per month in case of Recreation Centres & one time payment from Rs. 75,000/- to Rs. 1,00,000/-. The Minister assured the delegation members that pending recreation grant would be released shortly. As regards old age pension, he told that action has been taken on 50000 cases for its payment & balance 27000 cases would be disposed of either taking help from SCAs / NGO or through Govt. J.R. Gupta replied specific questions regarding rights of the senior citizens & remedy available before parents whose children are not looking after them. Parents can file simple application with concerned Tribunal Court of District Magistrate for their eviction within 90 days & claim maintenance allowance of Rs. 10,000/- per month under Maintenance of Parents & Welfare of Senior Citizens Act, 2007 implemented in Delhi in the year of 2009. Other both speakers replied about legalities. In concluding remarks, J.R. Gupta, advised Senior Citizens of Delhi not to transfer their properties by way of Gift Deed or Sale Deed & rather go for Will so that they could be looked after very well during their life time. **—Editor.**

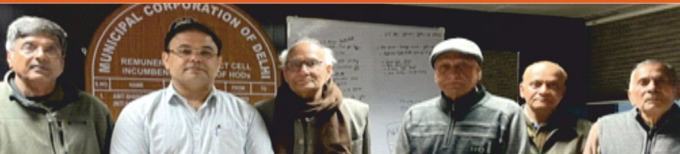
