LT. GOVERNOR, DELHI ACCEPTS THE DEMAND OF CONFEDERATION TO OPEN ALL DDA PARKS ACROSS DELHI FROM 21-06-2021 & ONWARDS



J.R.Gupta, Chairperson, Confederation of Senior Citizens Associations of Delhi (an umbrella body of 18 Lakh senior citizens) addressed a letter by email to **Sh. Anil Baijal, Lt. Governor of Delhi** on 17-06-2021 requesting opening of all DDA parks across Delhi to enable citizens of Delhi including children, younger & elders to have regular morning walk near their respective colonies across Delhi. It was further mentioned that all malls, market, wine shops, restaurants and weekly markets including buses & Delhi metro are already operational. Moreover, it was also brought to his notice that citizens of Delhi had been forced to remain in their houses since, lock down announced in April, 2021 during second wave of Covid-19 pandemic particularly grandparents as they were being ignored by their own family members. Earlier during first wave of Covid-19 in 2020 they had freedom to go for morning walk. An example of Doctors of AIIMS & Safdarjung Hospital was also brought to his notice as they had regularly going for morning walk on those days before going to their duties. Confederation is grateful to Lt. Governor, Delhi who accepted our request & all DDA parks were opened on 21-06-2021 from 6:00 am & onwards.

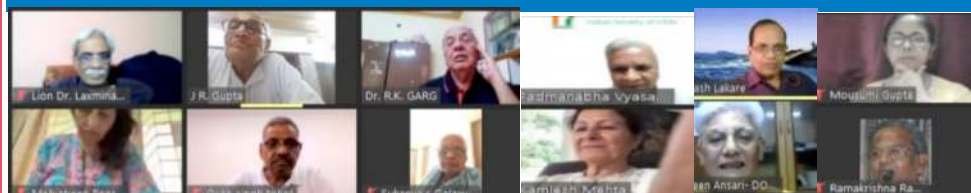
ACTIVITIES OF SCWM, TAGORE GARDEN

Starting with a definition of a Fall as an unplanned event, she went on to explain risk factors (internal, external and environmental) causing falls, then described four phases of a fall, fall prevention training, exercises, risk assessment after a fall, what doctors should do, preparing the house to prevent falls, role of physiotherapist, etc. followed by Q&A session. INCOME TAX BENEFITS IN FY 2020-21

Senior Citizen Above the age of 60 years .Super Senior Citizen Above the age of 80 years , **A)** Senior Citizen Rs.3,00,000 • Super Senior Citizen Rs.5,00,000 Under Section 87A – No tax if the total income is less than Rs.5 lakhs Example :Total Income 5,00,000 Exemption 3,00,000 , Taxable Income 2,00,000, Tax at 5 %Rs.10,000 , Rebate under Sec.87 A Rs.10,000 , Tax Payable Nil . **B)** Advance Tax Section 208 If the tax payable for the year exceeds Rs.10,000 in the year –Advance Tax Payable by every body as per Sec.211. But the Senior Citizen is exempted from payment of Advance Tax. **C)** Standard Deduction .If the Senior Citizen is a retired employee of State / Central Government , then from the total income from Pension Amounting to Rs.50,000 **D)** Exemption on Interest Income Section 80TTB, Interest Income under the following, Interest on Savings Bank Account, Interest on Fixed Deposits Interest on Recurring Deposits **E)** In Banks, Post Offices • Exemption : Upto Rs.50,000, Also, there will be no deduction of tax at source upto 50,000. This limit of 50,000 has to be computed for every bank individually ., Example : Investment of Rs.6 lakhs at 8% = No TDS, Senior Citizens may submit Form 15H –not to deduct TDS on the interest income if it exceeds this limit. Provided the total income should not be more than Rs.3 lakhs in the year , **F)** Section 80D, Medical Insurance Premium Paid on the Health Insurance , Deduction from the total income upto Rs.50,000, Medical Expenses –Deduction upto Rs.50,000, (allowed for existing diseases). Under both Maximum Deduction upto Rs.50,000, Health Check up –Expenses upto Rs.5,000 deduction allowed , Deduction under section 80DDB is allowed for medical treatment of a dependant who is suffering from a specified disease . **i)** Can be claimed by an Individual or HUF **ii)** Allowed to Resident Indians , **iii)** When taxpayer has spent money on treatment of the dependant **iv)** Dependant shall mean spouse, children , parents and siblings **v)** In case the dependant is insured and some payment is also received from an insurer or reimbursed from an employer , such insurance or reimbursement received shall be subtracted from the deduction . **G)** Limit under Sec.80DDB Upto Rs.1,00,000 or the actual amount , whichever is less Diseases cover like **i)** Neurological **ii)** Cancers **iii)** Aids **iv)** Renal Failure **v)** Hematological disorders **H)** Reverse Mortgage Available to the Senior Citizens Monthly EMI or Lumpsum Amount payable /paid by the Bank is exempted under section 10(43). Section 80C Senior Citizens Saving Scheme Deposit made under the scheme qualify for the deduction under this section .Lock in period of deposits –5 years All the above benefits available only to the Resident Senior Citizens E-filings of ITR-1 (Sahaj) and ITR-4 (Sugam) are not mandatory for Very Senior Citizens and they may file their return of income either Online or Offline , while no other assessee can file Offline Return **I)** Caution Budget 2020 , provides an opportunity to choose between a new-tax regime or continue with the old -tax regime . The tax rate for FY 20-21 is different on the basis of the regime chosen by the individual .There is no separate category for Individuals as Senior Citizen. Under the new tax regime, all deductions discussed are not available .Hence depending upon the income , it is required to make a tax planning under both old and new and the best is to be adopted. -compiled by Mrs. Manjula Aggarwal, Incharge
