Delhi Police Advisory Body Meeting on 1.5.14



A State level Delhi Police Advisory Body meeting was held on 01/05/2014 at Delhi Police headquarters under the Chairmanship of Shri S.B.K. Singh, I.P.S., Special Commissioner to discuss Safety and Security of senior citizens, identification & registration of senior citizens living alone, conduction of security audit, creation of awareness about the Maintenance & Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens, Rules 2007 and Delhi Maintenance & Welfare of Parents & Senior Citizens Rules, 2010. Eminent senior citizens across Delhi participated along with D.C.P. level officers of all the Districts including Shri Ravinder Yadav, Joint Commissioner (Crime) & Shri Anil Shukla, Joint Commissioner (Traffic) were also present. On behalf of Confederation of Senior Citizens Association of Delhi, J.R. Gupta attended the meeting and offered his full support for holding a big conclave of senior citizens to create awareness about all the points referred to above including the Maintenance Act, 2007 & Delhi State Rules, 2010 which was appreciated by the Chairman. The members present also pointed out about the traffic problems including encroachments in their respective colonies. Shri J.R. Gupta also raised the issue regarding encroachments of service lane facing Africa Avenue, Safdarjung Enclave by Mahindra Car Showroom, old car dealers and Nova Hospital and even the residents has to wait sometime for hours due to congestion of traffic in the service lane in spite of complaints to local traffic police. He

also handed over a copy of Review Order of Tribunal Court in favor of Smt. Hitabhilashi Sharma, widow aged 75 years to Shri. Rajan Bhagat, Additional DCP for vacating ground floor of House No. 69 Harsh Vihar, Pitam Pura by her Son Oj Kumar Sharma for her use with a request to ask SHO Rani Bagh for its compliance at the earliest. Shri. Rajan Bhagat assured to do the needful. Shri Gupta further, emphasized to the need of traffic signal on Harsukh Marg, just opposite to B-5 gate of Deer Park as the morning/evening walkers including senior citizens, children and women are feeling inconvenience while crossing the road and has to wait for long time to cross the road as the traffic is very heavy. Shri Anil Shukla assured to look into the issues at his personal level shortly. After hearing the views of all the participants, Shri S.B.K. Singh, assured to take remedial measures to address their grievances.

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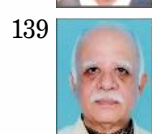

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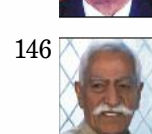
