NATIONAL SEMINAR ON STATUS OF SENIOR CITIZENS IN INDIA & THEIR ROLE IN NATIONAL BUILDING FROM 17 TO 19/09/2022 AT LAKSHMI EMPIRE HOTEL, MADGAON, GOA



ISU3A organized National Seminar on status of Senior Citizens in India & their role in National Building from 17 to 19/09/2022 at Lakshmi Empire Hotel, Madgaon, Goa in which 87 members participated after coming from different parts of India. Following recommendations were made ie 1. The old age pension should be increased to at least Rs. 5000/- per month. 2. The Govt. Should consider higher return on bank FDRs by at least 2%, as against the present 0.5%. 3. The Govt. should restore concession to senior citizens on Railway tickets. 4. There should be an increase in income tax (slab) limit for senior citizen to 7.5 lakh, and no tax should be deducted. 5. MWPSA Act. 2007 to be suitably amended to make it more effective, based on resolutions of similar conferences / seminars held exclusively on this topic. 6. Govt. to provide budget for constructing at least one old age home in each district, and ensure its proper maintenance. 7. Like the National Policy on Senior Citizen (NPSC-2012), the State govts should also be asked to formulate and declare their own revised state policy, and its implementation. State Councils of Senior citizens should be established for effective monitoring of policies and programmes for senior

citizens. 8. The NCSC and SCSC should have adequate representation from major Senior Citizens Organizations. 9. The central Government may consider issuing an advisory or request to corporate houses for spending at least 5 or 10% from their CSR funds for senior citizens schemes. 10. MOSJE should conduct regular periodical meetings with Senior Citizens Associations to address their problems. It was decided to send letters to Central Govt & State Govts. **Meeting with Chief Minister.** The most important event during the Seminar was A Visit of our Executive Chairperson, J.R. Gupta met Sh. Pramod Sawant, CM, GOA at his residence along with nine members on 18/09/2022 evening. The CM heard the problems of Senior Citizens and assured that the problems will be addressed and solved amicably, as far as GOA is concerned. Other members enjoyed sightseeing & dinner in Cruise. The event ended with a group photo and vote of thanks for all. Lodging arrangements in the hotel, service of hotel staff, the breakfast / lunch / dinner served were splendid. As someone remarked everything was superb. The recommendations of the Seminar will be forwarded to all the Central Government as well as all the State Governments by SG. A report by Dr. R. K. 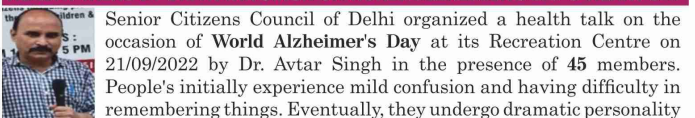

J.R. Gupta told the members that Confederation members would meet Sh. Ram Niwas Guel, Speaker, Delhi Vidhan Sabha in the first week of October, 2022 to get appointment with either CM or Dy. CM by 15th October, 2022. He also informed the members that enhanced recreation grants already approved in a meeting dated 27.07.2016, chaired by Hon'ble Social Welfare Minister, Sh.
