AIR INDIA OFFERS 50% DISCOUNT TO SENIOR CITIZENS

In a relief to senior citizens, retirees aged over 60 years will now be able to avail 50% discount on Air India flights on domestic routes. The national carrier has lowered the age limit to 60 for availing travel concession under its scheme for senior citizens. Earlier, the age limit for senior citizens to avail this offer was 65. The decision by Air India of revising the age limit has been implemented with immediate effect for all domestic sectors. According to the revised rule, any senior citizen, who is permanently resident in India and has attained the age of 60 on the date of commencement of journey, shall be entitled to a 50% discounted ticket in economy class on the basic RBD (reservation booking designators) fare. Other competitive airlines like SpiceJet, Indigo and Jet Airways are already offering discounts to senior citizen who are aged 60 years and above.

Travel: Any sector within India, **Ticket Validity:** 1 Year from date of issue, **Advance Purchase:** Not required. Ticket can be purchased anytime, **Date/Flight change, Cancellation & Refund:** Permitted - Fee applied.

RELIEF FOR CGHS BENEFICIARIES

Beneficiaries of the Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) need not visit wellness centres to buy their prescription medicines, and can buy them from regular medical stores till 30-09-2020. The need for a non-availability certificate has been temporarily done away as beneficiaries were required to submit bills at wellness centres where their cards are registered for reimbursement. Director Sanjay Jain said that the move was taken in view of the lockdown. Also permitted issue of drugs to authorised representatives of beneficiaries aged above 60 years, those undergoing immuno-suppressant treatment like organ transplant and chemotherapy, uncontrolled diabetes/de-compensated cardiac status, or other illness compelling home stay.

RBI BONDS ALLOWS PREMATURE WITHDRAWALS TO SENIOR CITIZENS

The Government of India allowed RBI to issue Floating Rate Savings Bond from July 1, 2020. The interest rate for the period July 1 to December 31, 2020 has been fixed at 7.15% which will be payable on January 1 next year.

The interest rate on RBI Floating Rate Savings Bond will be reset every six months. These bonds have a 1,000 maturity period of seven years. Any person who is a resident irrespective of the age can invest in these bonds, a Hindu undivided family can also invest. Investors in the age group of 60 years and above are allowed to make premature withdrawals after the end of minimum lock-in period. Lock-in period for investors in the age bracket of 60-70 years is six years from the date of issue. Lock-in for investors in the age bracket of 70 to 80 years is five years from the date of issue and for investors aged 80 years and above, the lock-in period is four years from the date of issue. Premature withdrawal will be allowed subject to the submission of date of birth document in support of age to the satisfaction of the issuing bank. In case of joint holders or more than two holders of bonds, any one of the holders can fulfill the eligibility criteria to make withdrawals before maturity. There is a penalty for premature withdrawal in RBI Savings Bonds to the tune of 50% of interest due and payable for the last six months of the holding period. RBI Savings Bonds are not tradable in the secondary market. Interest on the RBI Floating Rate Savings Bond are fully taxable and tax will be deducted while making payment of interest on bonds from time to time. An investor can invest in bonds for a minimum sum of There is no maximum limit.

PRIVATE HOSPITALS EMPANELLED UNDER CGHS WOULD CHARGE FIXED RATES FOR COVID -19 TREATMENT

Private hospitals empanelled under the Central Government Health Scheme will charge from beneficiaries the rates prescribed by the Delhi government for COVID-19 treatment till their States fix its own charges. An office memorandum issued by the CGHS Director said. The rates for treatment of COVID-19 in private empanelled hospitals for CGHS beneficiaries shall be as per the package rate prescribed by the State Government concerned. In case, no such rate has been prescribed by the State Government in any CGHS city, the rates prescribed by the Government of NCT Delhi, shall be applicable till rates are notified by the concerned State Government," the memorandum dated July 10 read. The Delhi government last month issued an order fixing the cost of a COVID-19 isolation bed in any private hospital in the range of Rs 8,000-10,000 and an ICU bed with ventilator at Rs 15,000-18,000 per day. According to the memorandum, the Health Ministry received representations regarding clarifications and guidelines on rates applicable for treatment at private healthcare organisations empanelled under the CGHS, following which the matter was reviewed. For non-COVID-related treatment in private hospitals empanelled under the scheme, the normal CGHS package rate shall be admissible, the memorandum stated. The test shall be permitted as per the ICMR guidelines and the CGHS rate shall be as per the rates fixed by State Governments or actual, whichever may be less. If the State Government has not notified such rates, the rates prescribed by the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) are applicable till rates are notified by State Govt -- **EDITOR**
